Dear Parents and Carers,

The hot temperatures continued this week and thank you for sending sun-hats and water bottles in for the children to stay as safe and cool as possible throughout the day. Just a reminder that children can wear the lighter-weight summer uniform this term. The summer uniform includes the blue and white gingham dress (navy blue rather than light blue dress and no playsuits) or a plain white polo tee-shirt and grey school trousers or grey tailored shorts.
