Year 6 parents and family members are invited to join us for the **Year 6 End of Year Play** at the **Junior School on Tuesday 14th July at 6.00pm.**

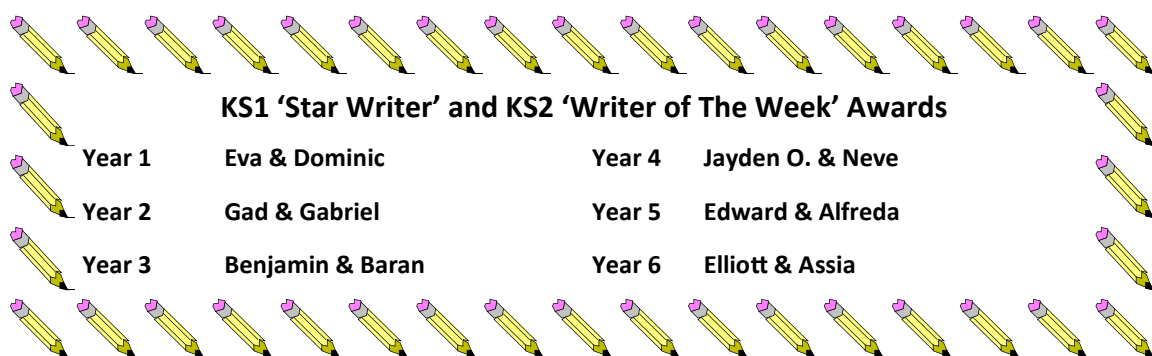
We also have the final **Rock Steady concerts** taking place on **Thursday 16th July at 9.30am in the Junior School and 2.30pm in the Infant School.**

Celebration of The Word

The Gospel for Sunday 21st June 2026

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus is sending out his disciples to heal and to preach the good news. Even if they are met with anger and threats, they must be true to Jesus. Jesus himself was not afraid to speak the truth and now his disciples must courageously do the same. This Gospel reminds us not to be afraid to speak out for what is right and true. **The Word** we are celebrating this week is **Courage**.

Jesus instructed the twelve as follows: "Do not be afraid. For everything that is now covered will be uncovered, and everything now hidden will be made clear. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the daylight; what you hear in whispers, proclaim from the house-tops. Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; think more about God who has power over both body and soul. Can you not buy two sparrows for a penny? And yet not one falls to the ground without your Father knowing. Why, every hair on your head has been counted. So there is no need to be afraid; you are worth more than hundreds of sparrows. So if anyone declares himself for me in the presence of men, I will declare myself for him in the presence of my Father in heaven.
