What was a horse and cart used for?	Horses and carts were used by people to travel and transport goods to other places.
How did the steam locomotive change lives?	George Stephenson invented the Rocket it had a steam engine. The steam engine changed the way people moved goods and travelled. Many city people were able to travel to the seaside for the first time.
Who flew the first plane?	The Wright brothers were the first people to successfully fly in a plane. It could only carry the pilot. It was made of wood cloth and had a small engine.
How are modern planes different?	Modern planes are bigger and faster. They are made from metal and have big powerful jet engines. They can carry over a hundred passengers.
