Key Facts	
Who was Florence Nightingale?	Florence worked as a nurse during the Crimean War and helped improve the conditions of hospitals.
What were hospitals like during the Crimean War.	The hospitals were filthy, dirty, dangerous and unhygienic. Soldiers died from disease in hospital.
Why is Florence Nightingale famous?	She is known as the lady with the lamp as she cared for injured soldiers each night using a lamp. She gave them clean bandages, water and food.
How are modern hospitals different?	Modern hospitals are cleaner, safer and hygienic with nurses wearing protective clothing. Anti-septic spray is used to stop disease spreading.
