Who was Mary Seacole?	Mary rode a horse into Crimea battlefields to care for wounded men on both sides of the war?
What was the British hotel?	A hut close to the battlefield where soldiers could rest, buy hot food, drink and equipment.
Why is Mary Seacole famous?	For her bravery in caring for sick and injured soldiers. She was awarded medals by Britain, Turkey, and France.
How are modern hospitals different?	Modern hospitals are cleaner, safer and hygienic with nurses wearing protective clothing. Anti-septic spray is used to stop disease spreading.
