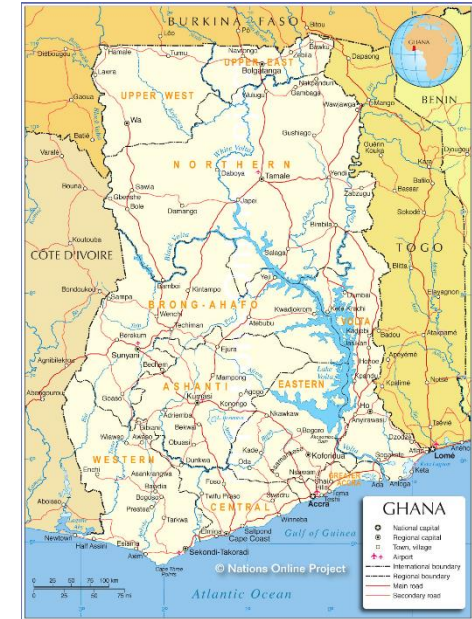




Previous Knowledge
