## Key Facts

What is Burnt Oak like?	Burnt Oak is a town about 9 miles from central London. It has shops, a park, houses, medical centre, church, schools, leisure centre in the local area.
Compass	A compass has four main directions: North, South, East and West. The needle in a compass points north. You work out which direction you are going depending on where north is.
