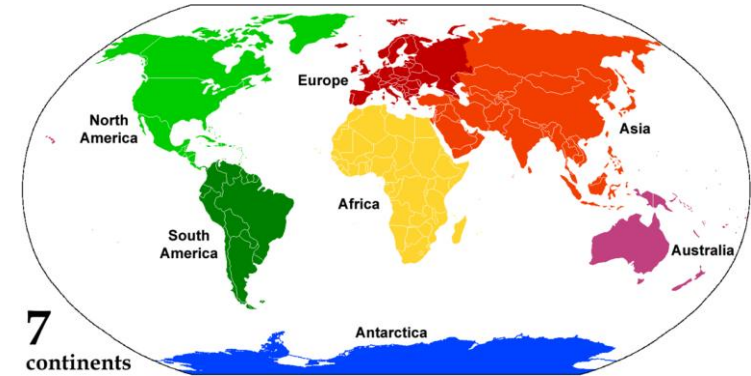




### Previous Knowledge

### Key Facts

What is a continent and an Ocean?	A continent is a very large land mass. There are seven continents in the world. There are five oceans in the world.
What are the seven continents and five oceans in the world?	The seven continents in size order from largest to smallest Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia. There are five oceans in the World Arctic, Atlantic, Indian, Pacific and Southern Oceans.

### Key Vocabulary

Continent	A very large land mass
World	The earth, together with all of its countries and people.
Ocean	Body of salt water that covers the surface of Earth.
Map	A representation of an area of land
Landmark	An object or feature of a landscape
Globe	A spherical rounded object that represents the Earth.
Climate	The weather conditions in an area.
Temperate	A climate that has mild temperatures
Tropical	An area near the Equator
Polar	Relating to the North and South poles - freezing temperatures and snow
