

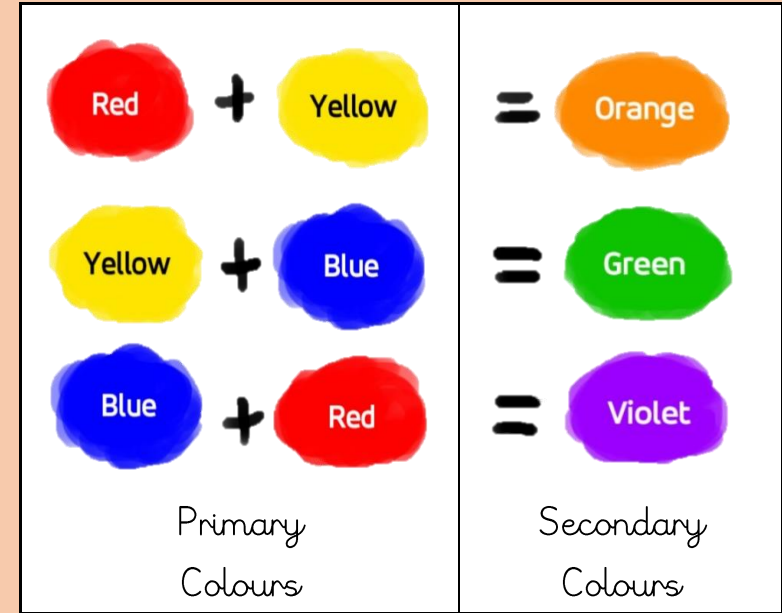


Alma Woodsey Thomas (1891-1978)

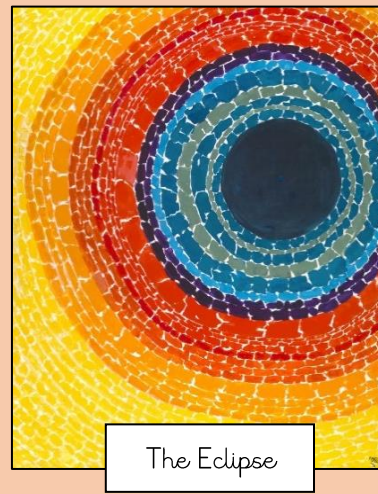
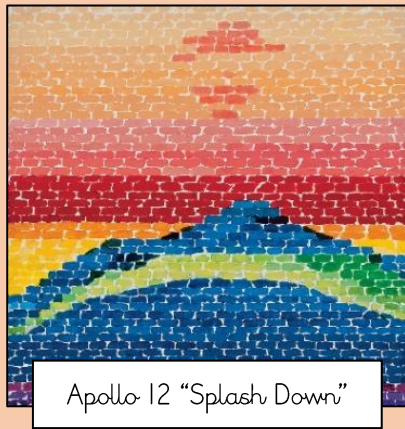
Alma Thomas was an African-American artist. She lived in Washington, which is in the United States.
