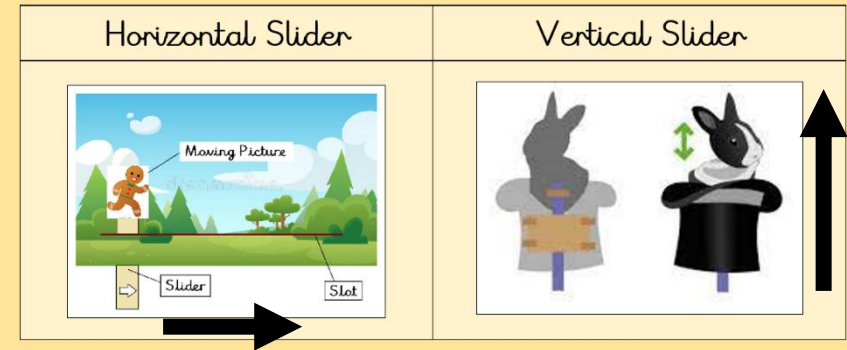

Technical Knowledge		
Sliders are mechanisms that provide movement. Identifying whether a mechanism is an up-and-down (vertical) or a side-to-side (horizontal) slider and determining what movement the mechanism will make.		

Key Vocabulary	
Mechanism	A device that links two or more pieces to create movement
Slider	A rigid bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line
Horizontal	A line that goes from left to right across the page. This is because horizontal lines are parallel to the horizon.
Vertical	A line that goes up to down.
Slot	The hole through which a slider is placed to enable part of a picture to move.
