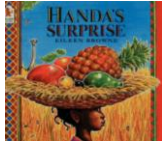

## Prior learning and an overview

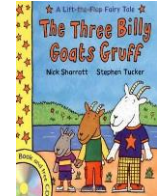
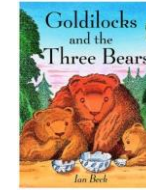


- Retold stories with predictable phrases.

## Content - What am I writing about?

- Retelling a story with characters and a setting.



## Structure - How do I set my instructions out?

**Beginning** - Who are the characters? Where is it set?

**Problem** - Something goes wrong!

**Middle** - What do they do?

**End** - They solve the problem!



## What words and techniques should I use?

Describe a character

Describe a setting

Adjectives make my writing interesting!

Story language - Once upon a time/A long time ago/One fine, sunny day

Write in full sentences, using punctuation.

Use conjunctions like 'and'/'because' to extend my ideas.

Punctuation . ? !

Capital letters (ABC) to start a sentence and for a name.

Full stops (.) to end a sentence.

Question marks (?) to end a question.

Exclamation marks to show a strong feeling

Fiction	Made up (not real)
Characters	People/creatures in the story
Setting	Where the story takes place.
Structure	The way it is set out.
