## **Nursery and PE Uniform – Ordering for next School Year**

As you are aware, the PE and Nursery uniform at school includes **two pieces of navy clothing with our school logo, the jogging bottoms and sweatshirt**. Unfortunately, our previous supplier ended orders with the school last year and we have been working with other suppliers to find suitable high-quality pieces of clothing and compare prices. We know many parents were unable to replace the logo pieces of uniform when children needed a new size or a spare and we are very appreciative of your patience while we found a new supplier.

We are very pleased to let you know that we are now working with **ACE Clothing** to provide our PE/Nursery uniform and both items shown on the page below are **now available to order online** via [www.aceclothing.co.uk](http://www.aceclothing.co.uk)

Ace Clothing have advised that orders should be placed by **4th August 2025** to ensure delivery before the start of Autumn term. They can offer a monthly delivery to the Infant and Junior schools at the end of each month. To be included in the school delivery option, orders must be placed by the 15th of that month.

Ace Clothing are based in Wembley and also offer collection in-store and home delivery options.

Children in Nursery class wear the new jogging bottoms and sweatshirt as their daily uniform and pupils from Reception to Year 6 wear the school PE uniform on the two days each week they have PE lessons. Alternatives to the logo pieces should not be worn, for example, sweatshirts or jogging bottoms with no school logo, cycle shorts or lycra leggings. Children should continue to wear a plain white round-neck tee-shirt as part of the PE uniform and may wear the navy shorts shown on our 'Uniform Guide Checklist' in warmer weather.

We understand some parents may still be waiting for their uniform order to be delivered at the start of term, however all orders should be made by September and children wearing the new uniform by October half-term at the latest.

The Ace Clothing website has size guides to help with ordering the two pieces of uniform. In addition, samples of the jogging bottoms and sweatshirts in different sizes will be available for parents to view at each school from mid next week.

All other items of school uniform can be purchased from large supermarkets or clothing shops, with the exception of the Junior School tie and the bookbag for each school. These items are purchased through ParentPay at the school offices.
