We had another exciting week across both schools.


Our Nursery pupils have been investigating what the **Naughty Bus** has been getting up to and they have had great fun. Meanwhile in reception the 'Evil Pea' was on the loose trapping **Super Tato and his vegetable friends**. The Reception children were on an exciting mission to find him.



Our Year 1 pupils have continued to focus on their text '**The Owl Babies**' and have been generating their own exciting versions of the story.

Setting descriptions was the focus for our Year 2 pupils, where they had the opportunity to create their own adventures for Emily Brown and Stanley.

Our Year 6 pupils have been studying **Macbeth** and this week they have written some brilliant diary entries in the role of Macbeth. Teachers were really impressed with the quality of their written work. Year 5 have been exploring a range of **historical enquiry questions** based on the similarities and differences between life in Tudor England and life in Benin. They shared their group research with their class.



Our Year 3 and 4 pupils have completed some great work in their science lessons with year four focusing on the differences between **vertebrates and invertebrates**. They went on a learning walk to gather information. Year 3 meanwhile were developing their knowledge of **forces** and made windmills to help with their investigations.

As you are aware during the **Autumn term** both schools hosted maths workshops for parents. Next week, we will be hosting **Reading Workshops** for parents in the **Infant School**.
