running stitch	A line of small, even stitches

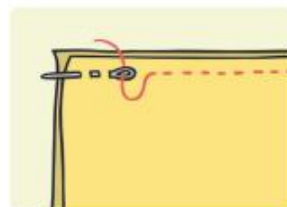

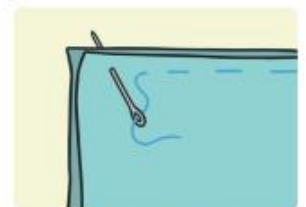
Prior Knowledge

- Measure, mark out, cut and shape materials/components with some accuracy
- Assemble, join and combine materials and components with increasing accuracy
- Apply a range of finishing techniques with increasing accuracy
- Use research for design ideas
- Produce a plan and explain it to others
- When designing, explore different initial ideas before coming up with a final design
- Refer to design criteria while designing and making
- Evaluate existing products, considering: how well they have been made, materials, whether they work, how they have been made and if they are fit for purpose
- Understand that materials have functional properties and aesthetic qualities

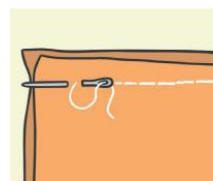

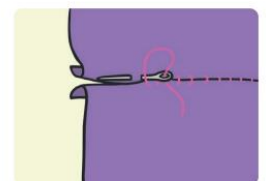
running stitch
