Spelling	Definition
Clay	Sticky earth
Modelling	Working clay into a shape or form.
Texture	How something feels (rough, smooth, prickly, etc)
Pinching	Squeezing between the thumb and a finger
Soft	Easily moulded
Shape	What your clay will look like
Form	A 3d shape
Structure	How something is made
Mark	Lines, dots, patterns, textures
Join	Squeezing or pressing together using the hands & fingers.
